After school, you play football.

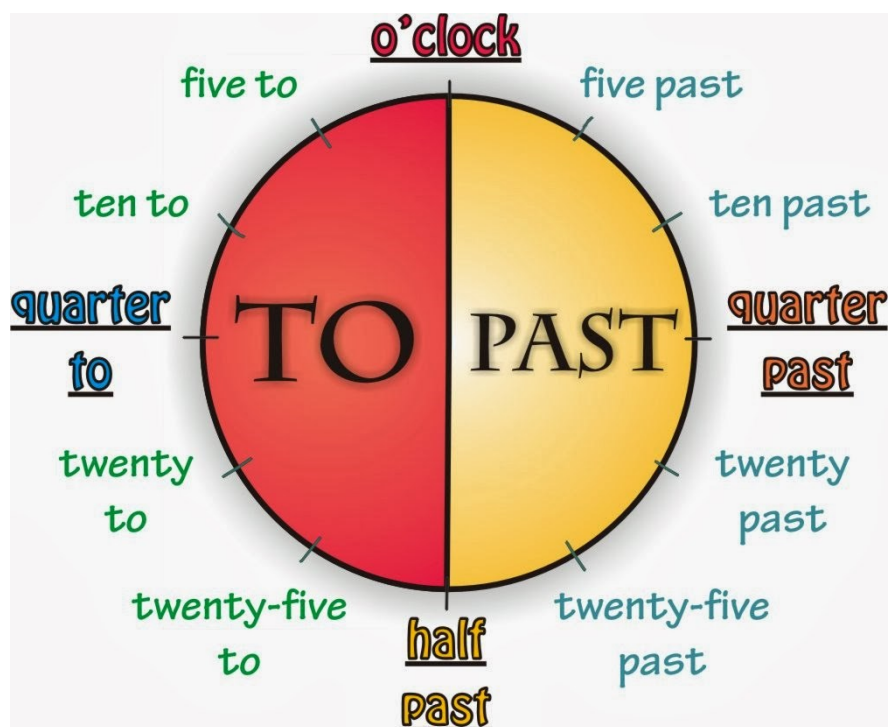
3. Décrire ses hobbies / ses leçons préférées
